2. **REGULATORY AUTHORITY:** 49 CFR § 107.807
3. **SYNOPSIS:** Mauria Udyog Limited is authorized to manufacture DOT 4BA and DOT 39 Specification cylinders at the location given above.
4. **BASIS:** This approval is issued in response to Mauria Udyog Limited's original application dated August 27, 2007, and subsequent request for revision to add DOT 39 manufacture dated July 15, 2008, followed by an inspection and audit at the manufacturing site and independent verification tests conducted at an approved laboratory.
5. **PERIOD OF VALIDITY AND CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL:** This approval does not provide relief from any requirements of the Hazardous Materials Regulations except as stated herein. This approval is valid until the posted expiration date or until terminated by the Associate Administrator for Hazardous Materials Safety.
 - a. **Approved Authority:** The holder of this approval is authorized to Manufacture and Mark the following DOT specification cylinders under the supervision of an independent inspection agency approved for that purpose in accordance with § 107.803:

**DOT 4BA and DOT 39 Cylinders - Manufactured in
accordance with §§ 178.35, 178.51, and 178.65.**

Only those designs on file with the department may be manufactured and marked under the terms of this approval.

b. Approved Independent Inspector: Only the following independent inspection agency is authorized to conduct on site inspection at your manufacturing facility:

c. Registration number: **M-0712** is your assigned registration number and must be marked on all DOT cylinders manufacture under the terms of this approval.

d. Safety Controls:

1) If DOT cylinder production has not been undertaken for more than six months, the Office of Hazardous Materials Special Permits and Approvals (OHMSPA) must be notified prior to resumption of production.

2) No deviation from designs, materials, method of manufacture, inspection procedures or any technical information submitted in support of the manufacturer's or inspector's applications for approval is authorized unless approved in accordance with 5.d.(4).

3) Failure to assure adequate independent inspection and verification will be grounds for termination or other enforcement action as provided for in the regulations.

4) Advance notice and written approval is required before any the following can be implemented:

a) Technical changes in the manufacturing processes or procedures are made.

b) Changes in the approved designs on file.

c) Adding a new design to be manufactured.

5) If non-technical information submitted in your application for approval changes, OHMSPA must be notified, in writing, within 20 days.

6. **SPECIAL PROVISIONS:** A current copy of this approval must be maintained and made available for examination at the location where cylinders are manufactured.

7. **GENERAL PROVISIONS:**

a. Failure by any person to comply with the terms and conditions of this approval and the Hazardous Materials Regulations, 49 CFR Parts 171-180, may result in the modification, suspension or termination of that person's authority to use this approval. Failure to comply may also subject that person to penalties prescribed by 49 U.S.C. §§ 5123 and 5124. This approval may be modified, suspended or terminated in its entirety if that action is justified in light of changes in circumstances or additional information not available when this approval was issued. Unless immediate modification, suspension or termination is necessary to avoid a risk of significant harm to persons or property, before action is taken, that person will be notified and provided with an opportunity to show why the proposed action should not be taken.

b. Each "Hazmat employee," as defined in § 171.8, who performs a function subject to this approval must be provided training on the requirements and conditions of this approval in addition to the training required by §§ 172.700 through 172.704.

c. Any person operating under the terms of this approval must comply with the security plan requirement in Subpart I of Part 172 of the HMR, when applicable.

d. This approval as revised supersedes all previous versions.
